Scaling down activities in Kavango East & West Regions

1. Introduction

Following the Mid-term review (MTR) of SCORE project several recommendations were made by the consultants on the best possible options for the project to continue with the remaining resources.

2. Recommendations from the MTR;

- The SCORE project needs to scale-down, and end activities in the two Kavango regions reason being:
 - The GIZ is already assisting MAWF-DAPEES in two regions with sufficient of resources for CA activities with the implementation of National Comprehensive Conservation Agriculture Programme. The SCORE project is also assisting the ministry in the similar way.
 - The CRAVE project is going to do the similar activities like those the SCORE project had been implementing in the region (Conservation Agriculture & mico-drip irrigation gardens).
 - Considering these the implementation of these activities in these two regions and the limited resources, it will be wise that the project scale-down its activities in these regions.

3. Activities to be carried out after scaling down

3.1. Micro-drip irrigation gardens

- Regular monitoring visits: Monthly monitoring of micro-drip irrigation gardens.
- Refresher training for MDI beneficiaries.

• Share awareness materials with the project beneficiaries and constituency office.

3.2. Conservation Agriculture

- Assist ATs during the ripping season (ensure that the CA beneficiary farmers are ripped for);
- Handover the CA activities to MAWF-DAPEES training of CA farmers and subsidized input provision
- Monitoring of project sites
- Share awareness materials with the project beneficiaries and constituency office.

3.3. Hand-dug wells

- Handover the hand dug wells to the beneficiaries and training of the beneficiaries to manage the hand dug wells;
- Share awareness materials with the project beneficiaries and constituency office.

4. Handover

- Meeting with MAWF-DAPEES, CRAVE and GIZ officials to share the MTR outcomes decisions by PSC on the way forward. Handover of project equipment to MAWF:
 - o April 2018
- Meeting with constituency officials to share the MTR outcomes decisions by PSC on the way forward:
 - o April/May 2018
- Meetings with Project beneficiaries to share the MTR outcomes decisions by PSC on the way forward:
