Explanatory Note:

Given the ongoing country situation after the military took over on 1 Feb 2021, UNDP developed engagement principles which were adopted by UN country Team. The principles guide MMR programming such that the benefits of programming accrue primarily and directly to the people or local communities without discrimination; that programming supports the strengthening of the rule of law and the protection and promotion of human rights; that it contributes to preserving the democratic space and supports humanitarian action and COVID responses. There will be no engagement or consultation with the military junta. Based on this, the existing programmes have to realigned according to the Engagement Principles and Evaluation plan has been reviewed and revised.
